People 6 months and older who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may receive additional doses of the updated COVID-19 vaccine (2023-2024 formula). Additional dose(s) may be administered as recommended by their healthcare provider.

Considerations:

The Janssen/Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 monovalent vaccine is no longer authorized for use.

Only the updated (2023-2024 formula) Moderna and Pfizer-BioNTech mRNA vaccines are authorized at this time; you can no longer receive the original or bivalent mRNA vaccines.

People ages 6 months – 64 years, and especially males ages 12 through 39 years may consider getting the 2nd dose of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna) 8 weeks after the 1st dose. A longer time between the 1st and 2nd doses may increase how much protection the vaccines offer and further minimize the rare risk of myocarditis and pericarditis.

Children ages 4 years and younger who received a Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine/vaccine series first must also get a Pfizer-BioNTech updated vaccine. Children ages 4 years and younger who received a Moderna vaccine/vaccine series first must also get a Moderna updated vaccine. Children ages 5 years and older who received a Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine/vaccine series and children ages 5 years and older who received a Moderna vaccine/vaccine series may receive either a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna updated vaccine regardless of the product used for prior doses. Teens and adults may receive either a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna updated vaccine regardless of the product used for prior doses. People who have previously received Novavax or Janssen vaccines may receive either a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna updated vaccine.
