Typical work week is Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 8 am – 4:30 pm, Wednesday 10 am – 6:30 pm and Friday 8 am – 4:00 pm. The schedule will be discussed in the interview process.

Job Duties: May include but not limited to assess and counsel clients for WIC program, certify participants per State policies, provide appropriate nutrition education, charting, anthropometric measurements and hemoglobin testing. Prescribe types and amounts of food for participants, serve as a nutrition resource person for RPH staff and other area health professionals.

Must be an Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics (AND) Registered Dietitian and be fully licensed by the Ohio Board of Dietetics.
