county. Screening Services Include:




Blood Pressure Reading Cost: FREE

This simple check screens for hypertension (high blood pressure) and hypotension (low blood pressure). * High blood pressure is a risk factor for cardiovascular disease.



Blood Sugar Check Cost: FREE (3-hour fast preferred)

This blood test screens for hyperglycemia (high blood sugar) and hypoglycemia (low blood sugar). One cause of high blood sugar is diabetes. *



Anemia Check Cost: FREE

With a small finger stick, the hemoglobin blood test checks the amount of protein in red blood cells. Low hemoglobin can be a sign of anemia.*



Cholesterol Check Cost: \$12.00. Cash or check only. (Requires 9-12-hour fast)

This blood test measures good cholesterol (HDL), bad cholesterol (LDL), and triglycerides. High cholesterol levels are a risk factor for cardiovascular disease.



Education and Referrals Cost: FREE

Receive information from a Public Health Nurse about various health issues and how to connect with community resources to assist you with your unique health and wellness needs.
